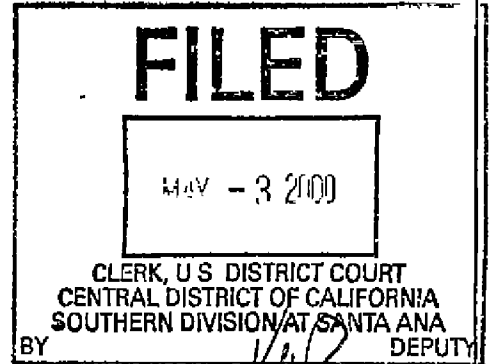

1 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin filed the instant putative class action under
2 Sections 10(b) and 20(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act")
3 on January 25, 2000.

4
5 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin, in accordance with the provisions Section
6 21D(a)(3)(A)(i) of the Exchange Act, on February 9, 2000, caused to be published over
7 the BUSINESS WIRE, a widely circulated national business-oriented wire service, a
8 notice advising class members of the pendency of the action, the claims asserted
9 therein, the purported class period, and their right to move this Court to be appointed
10 Lead Plaintiff.

11
12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21D of the Exchange Act, any purported class
13 member desiring to be appointed Lead Plaintiff was required to have filed a motion for
14 such appointment on or before April 10, 2000.

16 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin has filed a complaint and has timely moved to be
17 appointed Lead Plaintiff

19 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin has the largest financial interest in the relief
20 sought by the class

21
22 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin otherwise satisfies the requirements of Rule 23 of
23 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

25 WHEREAS, Plaintiff D. Colin, in accordance with Section 21D(a)(3)(B)(v) of
26 the Exchange Act, has sought approval of his selection of the law firms of Rabin &
27 Peckel LLP and The Law Office of Leo W. Desmond as Co-Lead Counsel.
