Appointment of Lead Plaintiffs and Organization of Counsel Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. 78u-4(a)(3)(B) and 15 U.S.C. 77z-1(a)(3)(B), the Public Employees Retirement System of Ohio and the State Teachers Retirement System of Ohio are appointed Lead Plaintiffs in the Consolidated Securities Action. The Court approves the Lead Plaintiffs' selection of Grant & Eisenhofer, P.A., as Lead Counsel in the Consolidated Securities Action.
