NOTICE OF APPEAL / APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF APPLICABILITY

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT VINCENT F. RIVERA, MOVANT (PLAINTIFF), APPEALS TO THE 3rd CCA, THE ORDER OF THIS COURT ENTERED ON 9.5.08. THE NATURE OF THE ORDER IS A FINAL ORDER DENYING MOTION TO INTERVENE. MY ISSUES ON APPEAL ARE AS FOLLOWS.

WHETHER THE ORDER BELOW REFLECTS AN ATTEMPT TO OBSCURE OR LIMIT THE PUBLIC'S KNOWLEDGE OF PRISON ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS, OR THE PRISON INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX, TYPIFYING "GOVERNMENT IN-THE-SUNSHINE".

WHETHER THE DEFENDANT ROYAL DUTCH/SHELL OPERATES ON THE SAME PLATFORM OF ILLEGAL CORPORATE POLITICAL DONATIONS; AS THE PRISON INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX (STATE-TO-STATE); AND THUS, PROMOTES ELECTION FRAUDS.

REASONS FOR GRANTING NOA/COR.

THE DISTRICT COURT DENIED MR. RIVERA'S MOTION TO INTERVENE AS PLAINTIFF, ON THE GROUNDS THAT A STATE PRISONER IS IN THE BEST POSSIBLE POSITION TO OVERTHROW THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S FARMARKING CULTURE OF CORRUPTION. THIS, BY DENYING MR. RIVERA ADEQUATE ACCESS THE COURT CAN BETTER PROTECT A STATE SECRET, WHICH IS THE STATES INVOLVEMENT IN THE BEFOREMENTIONED CULTURE OF CORRUPTION. All right, the Administration of Santa Rosa C.I. is operating a gasoline redemption scheme. One that encompasses the state's gubernatorial agencies, along with the legislative wing, which translates into the criminal justice apparatus. The House Fiscal Council, and the Florida Accounting & Auditing Board, Alex sink. As in 'Florida's Cook Book'. 



Yeah well, this is where the Warden at Santa Rosa CI is at fault. For him to elicit information from a state prisoner (Rivera) that would necessarily help the Elko administration cover up the same facts that the administration says cannot be supported, or substantiated; is a strong indicator of "Guilty Knowledge." The law is clear on this subject. Guilty Knowledge is an element of actual possession of narcotics that must be proven beyond and to the exclusion of every reasonable doubt (nolens volens).
