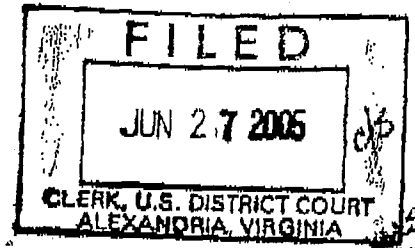

4(a)(3)(B)(ii), along with any future-filed or transferred tag-along action asserting federal securities claims relating to BearingPoint, Inc.

2. The instant actions and any tag-along actions shall be referred to herein as the "Consolidated Actions." This Order shall apply to the Consolidated Actions and to any and all cases that are subsequently filed in this Court or transferred to this Court, which action is brought against the defendants and/or any other past or present employee or agent of any defendant, which action is brought on behalf of purchasers of BearingPoint, Inc. securities.

3. This Court requests the assistance of counsel in calling to the attention of the clerk of this Court the filing or transfer of any case which might properly be consolidated as part of the Consolidated Actions.

II. MASTER DOCKET AND MASTER FILE

4. A Master Docket and Master File are hereby established for the Consolidated Actions. The Master File shall be Civil Action No. 1:05CV454 (TSE/TCB). Entries in the Master Docket shall be applicable to these Consolidated Actions as more fully set forth below, and entries shall be made in accordance with the regular procedures of the Clerk of the Court, except as modified by this Order.

5. The short caption for the Consolidated Actions shall be "*In re BearingPoint, Inc. Securities Litigation II*, Civil Action No. 1:05CV454 (TSE/TCB)." Every pleading in this Consolidated Action shall bear the following caption:

6. All future filings in the above-captioned consolidated actions and all subsequently filed related actions shall bear the file number of the first filed case, No. 1:05CV454;

7. The consolidated action shall proceed under the following caption: *In re BearingPoint, Inc., Securities Litigation II*;

8. The above caption shall be followed by the statement: **THIS MATTER RELATES TO;**

9. Where a filing relates to all actions, the statement in paragraph 3 shall be followed by the statement: **ALL ACTIONS;**

10. Where a filing relates to one or several, but not all, individual actions, the statement in paragraph 8 shall be followed by the name(s) and number(s) of the individual case(s) to which that filing relates;

11. All further filings shall be filed exclusively in the consolidated case file, and no further filings shall be filed in the individual cases.

III. NEWLY-FILED OR TRANSFERRED ACTIONS

12. When a case that arises out of the subject matter of this action is hereinafter filed in this Court or transferred from another Court, the Clerk of this Court shall:

- a. file a copy of this Order in the separate file for such action;

- b. mail a copy of this Order to the attorneys for the plaintiff(s) in the newly filed or transferred case and to any new defendant(s) in the newly filed or transferred case; and
- c. make the appropriate entry in the docket for this action.


13. Each new case which arises out of the subject matter of the Consolidated Actions that is filed in this Court or transferred to this Court shall be consolidated with this action and this order shall apply thereto, unless a party objecting to this Order or any provision of this Order shall, within (10) days after the date upon which a copy of this Order is served on counsel for such party, file an application for relief from this Order or any provision herein and this Court deems it appropriate to grant such application.

14. Counsel are **DIRECTED** to advise the Court of the date on which early notice to class members was provided in accordance with 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4 and the date 60 days thereafter by which any members of the purported class may file a motion to serve as lead plaintiff. On receiving these dates the Court will issue a further scheduling order.

15. Defendants in the Consolidated Actions need not file their answers or other responsive pleadings pursuant to Rule 12, Fed. R. Civ. P., until further order of the Court and pending the appointment of lead plaintiff, lead counsel and the filing of a class amended complaint.
