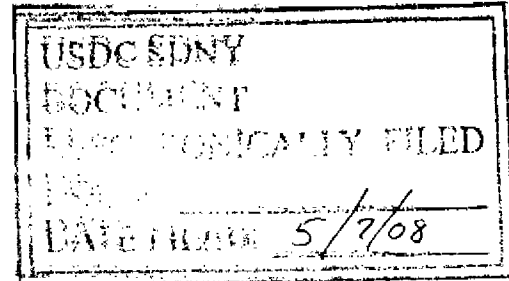

ORDER



Lead Plaintiffs have filed a letter motion requesting authorization to access the binary code of Grand Theft Auto: San Andreas ("GTA:SA"), which is otherwise protected by the End User License Agreement. Lead Plaintiffs have requested expedited consideration of their letter motion, on the grounds that their motion to amend is due on May 19, 2008. Given the complex issues attendant upon Lead Plaintiffs' request for "access," including the applicability of the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995, the Court hereby stays the briefing schedule for Lead Plaintiffs' motion to amend until it has rendered a decision on Lead Plaintiffs' request to view GTA:SA's binary code. After the Court has resolved Lead Plaintiffs' request for access, briefing of the motion to amend shall recommence under a new scheduling order to be issued by the Court.

Additionally, on May 14, 2008, the Court will place upon the public docket Lead Plaintiffs' letter motion dated April 30, 2008, the defendants' opposition letter dated May 5, 2008, and Lead Plaintiffs' reply letter dated May 6, 2008, as well as all

accompanying documentation, unless one or more parties to this dispute shows good cause to maintain the entirety or portions of these documents under seal.
