1 THIS MATTER having come before the Court on September 26, 2008 on the motion of  
2 Lead Plaintiffs for an award of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of expenses incurred, the Court,  
3 having considered all papers filed and proceedings conducted herein, having found the settlement of  
4 this action to be fair, reasonable and adequate and otherwise being fully informed in the premises  
5 and good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED  
6 that:

7 1. The Court hereby awards Lead Plaintiffs' Counsel attorneys' fees in the amount  
8 \_\_\_\_\_ percent (\_\_\_\_%) of the Settlement Fund, together with interest earned thereon  
9 for the same period and at the same rate as that earned on the Settlement Fund until paid, plus  
10 reimbursement of litigation expenses incurred in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ and also awards  
11 \$\_\_\_\_\_ to Lead Plaintiff Louisiana Municipal Police Employees Retirement System for  
12 reasonable costs and expenses incurred in the representation of the Class. The Court finds that the  
13 amount of fees awarded is fair and reasonable under the "percentage-of-the-recovery method and  
14 that the costs and expenses were reasonably incurred in connection with the pursuit of this litigation  
15 and were reasonable in amount.

16 2. The awarded attorneys' fees and expenses and interest earned thereon may be paid  
17 immediately after the date this Order is entered, subject to the terms, conditions and obligations of  
18 the Stipulation of Settlement.

19 3. There is no reason for delay in the entry of this Order Awarding Attorneys' Fees and  
20 Expenses and immediate entry by the Clerk of the Court is expressly directed pursuant to Rule  
21 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
