2 Administrative Motion to Consider Whether Cases Should Be Related. The Court, having  
3 considered the papers and pleadings on file, and good cause appearing,

4 HEREBY GRANTS Plaintiff Nick Pournaras' Administrative Motion to Consider Whether  
5 Cases Should be Related.

6 IT IS SO ORDERED that *Pournaras v. Pegasus Wireless et al.*, 3:07-cv-4600 (CRB) is  
7 reassigned to the undersigned Judge who is assigned the earliest filed case, *Mitchell v. Pegasus*  
8 *Wireless Corporation, et al.*, C-06-cv-6969;

9 Counsel are instructed that all further filings in an reassigned case are to bear the initials of  
10 the newly assigned judge immediately after the case number. Any case management conference in  
11 the reassigned *Pournaras* matter will be rescheduled by the Court. The parties shall adjust the dates  
12 for their conference, disclosures and report required by Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 16 and 26  
13 accordingly.

14 Unless otherwise ordered, any dates for hearing noticed motions are vacated and must be  
15 renoticed by the moving party before the newly assigned judge; any deadlines set by the ADR Local  
16 Rules remain in effect; and any deadlines established in a case management order continue to  
17 govern, except dates for appearance in court, which will be rescheduled by the newly assigned  
18 judge.
