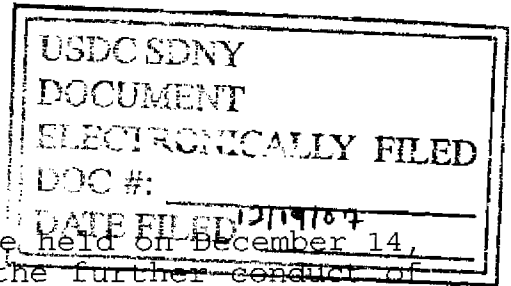

PRETRIAL
SCHEDULING ORDER



As set forth at the pretrial conference held on December 14, 2007, the following schedule shall govern the further conduct of pretrial proceedings in this case:

1. The parties shall comply with their Rule 26(a)(1), Fed.R.Civ.P., initial disclosure obligations by **January 4, 2008**.
2. Document production shall be substantially completed by **May 2, 2008**.
3. The next pretrial conference is scheduled for **May 9, 2008** at **10 a.m.** in Courtroom 11B, 500 Pearl Street.
4. A motion to certify a class shall be fully submitted by **May 30, 2008**.

At the time any Reply is served the moving party shall supply two courtesy copies of all motion papers to Chambers by delivering them to the Courthouse Mailroom, 8th Floor, United States Courthouse, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York.

5. All fact discovery must be completed by **October 17, 2008**.
6. Identification of experts and disclosure of expert testimony conforming to the requirements of Rule 26(a)(2)(B), Fed.R.Civ.P., by the party bearing the burden of proof on the issue must occur by **November 14, 2008**.
Identification of experts and disclosure of expert testimony in rebuttal must occur by **December 19, 2008**.
7. All expert discovery must be completed by **January 30, 2009**.
8. The following motion will be served by the dates indicated below.

Any motion for summary judgment


- Motion served by **February 20, 2009**
- Opposition served by **March 20, 2009**
- Reply served by **April 3, 2009**

At the time any Reply is served the moving party shall supply two courtesy copies of all motion papers to Chambers by delivering them to the Courthouse Mailroom, 8th Floor, United States Courthouse, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York.

9. In the event no summary judgment motion is filed, the Joint Pretrial Order must be filed by **February 20, 2009**.

As described in greater detail in this Court's Individual Practices in Civil Cases, the following documents must be filed with the Pretrial Order: Voir Dire, Requests to Charge and a Memorandum of Law addressing all questions of law expected to arise at trial. Any responsive papers are due one week thereafter. Counsel will provide the Court with two (2) courtesy copies of all pretrial documents at the time of filing.
