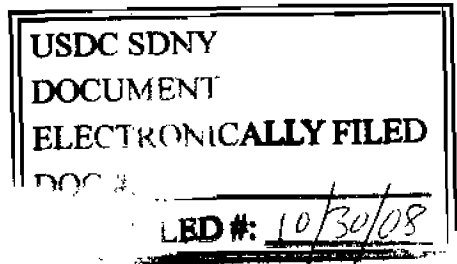

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2008, this Court issued an Order approving the parties' proposed scheduling stipulation;

WHEREAS, the July 29, 2008 Order and Stipulation addressed a pending Motion to Transfer for Coordination before the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation;

WHEREAS, the July 29, 2008 Order and Stipulation provided that, in the event the Motion to Transfer was denied, the parties would confer and, within twenty days of the denial of the Motion to Transfer, submit a proposed briefing schedule to this Court;

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2008, the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation denied the Motion to Transfer;

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WHEREAS, ^{*parties claim that the*} the legal and factual claims in this securities matter are complex and will be asserted on behalf of a putative class;

WHEREAS, the parties are in agreement that lead plaintiff and the defendants should have roughly equal time periods in which to submit the amended complaint and to answer, move,

or otherwise respond to the amended complaint;

THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated and agreed by the parties, by and through their undersigned counsel, that:

1. Lead plaintiff Laurie Rubin shall submit an amended complaint on or before December ~~18~~³¹, 2008;

2. Defendants shall answer, move, or otherwise respond to the amended complaint on or before ~~February 5~~^{January 7}, 2009;

3. If defendants move to dismiss, lead plaintiff's response thereto shall be filed on or before ~~March 2~~^{February 6}, 2009

4. If defendants move to dismiss, defendants' reply brief shall be filed on or before ~~April 15~~^{February 20}, 2009.

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
