ORDER AUTHORIZING DISTRIBUTION OF NET SETTLEMENT FUND

Before the Court is Lead Plaintiffs’ Motion for Distribution of Net Settlement Fund. The Court finds that the Motion should be granted.

By Order and Final Judgment dated November 29, 2010, the Court approved the settlement as fair, reasonable and adequate and reserved exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the action for the purpose of, among other things, supervising the distribution of the settlement fund.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The administrative determinations and recommendations of the Garden City Group (“Garden City”) accepting and rejecting the claims submitted herein are approved;

2. The fees and expenses of Garden City in the amount of \$185,036.87 shall be paid out of the settlement fund to Garden City for its additional fees and expenses incurred and to be incurred in connection with services performed and to be performed with respect to the administration of the settlement;

3. Garden City is hereby authorized to distribute the Net Settlement Fund to Class Members whose Proofs of Claim have been accepted;

4. Any funds that remain from the settlement amount, after the payments described in the Affidavit of Jason Zuena have been made, will be paid as a *cy press* charitable contribution to Legal Aid Services of Oklahoma, Inc;

5. One year after distribution of the Net Settlement Fund, Garden City shall destroy the paper copies of the Proofs of Claims and all supporting documentation, and three years after distribution of the Net Settlement Fund, Garden City shall destroy electronic copies of same; and

6. The Court finds that the administration of the Settlement and the proposed distribution of the Net Settlement Fund comply with the terms of the Stipulation and the Plan of Allocation approved by this Court and that all persons involved in the review, verification, calculation, tabulation, or any other aspect of the processing of the claims submitted herein, or otherwise involved in the administration or taxation of the Settlement Fund or the Net Settlement Fund (including, but not limited to Lead Plaintiffs' counsel) are released and discharged from any and all claims arising out of such involvement, and all Class Members, whether or not they are to receive payment from the Net Settlement Fund, are barred from making any further claim against the Net Settlement Fund or the released persons beyond the amount allocated to them pursuant to this Order.
