Having considered the motion of Ironworkers St. Louis District Council Pension Fund (“Ironworkers”) for Consolidation, Appointment as Lead Plaintiff and Approval of Selection of Lead and Liaison Counsel, and good cause appearing therefor:

1. The above-captioned related actions are hereby consolidated for all purposes and shall now be captioned as *In re Constellation Energy Group, Inc. Securities Litigation*, Civil No. CCB-08-2854;

2. Ironworkers is hereby appointed Lead Plaintiff for the Class pursuant to Section 27 of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 21D of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934;

3. The law firm of Coughlin Stoia Geller Rudman & Robbins LLP is hereby appointed Lead Counsel and the law firm of Brown Goldstein Levy, LLP is hereby appointed Liaison Counsel;

4. Lead Counsel shall have the following responsibilities and duties to perform or delegate as appropriate:

- (a) to brief and argue motions;
- (b) to initiate and conduct discovery, including, without limitation, coordination of discovery with defendants' counsel, the preparation of written interrogatories, requests for admissions, and requests for the production of documents;
- (c) to direct and coordinate the examination of witnesses in depositions;
- (d) to act as spokesperson at pretrial conferences;
- (e) to initiate and conduct any settlement negotiations with counsel for defendants;
- (f) to consult with and employ experts;
- (g) to call and chair meetings of plaintiffs' counsel as appropriate or necessary from time to time;

(h) to provide general coordination of the activities of plaintiffs' counsel and to delegate work responsibilities to selected counsel as may be required in such a manner as to lead to orderly and efficient prosecution of this litigation and to avoid duplication or unproductive effort;

(i) to receive and review periodic time reports of all attorneys on behalf of plaintiffs, to determine if the time is being spent appropriately and for the benefit of plaintiffs, and to determine and distribute plaintiffs' attorneys' fees; and

(j) to perform such other duties as may be expressly authorized by further order of this Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
