

ORDER DISMISSING CASE WITH PREJUDICE

THIS MATTER came before the Court *sua sponte*. Review of the record indicates that the parties have not filed their Stipulation of Dismissal. On January 3, 2011, the Court entered an order requiring the parties to file their Stipulation of Dismissal by January 28, 2011 [DE-116]. That order stated that failure to comply may result in the final dismissal of this case. On January 21, 2011, the Court granted the Plaintiff's request for Additional to Complete Stipulation and ordered the parties to file their Stipulation of Dismissal by February 11, 2011. No Stipulation of Dismissal was filed. On February 17, 2011, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause giving the parties until February 28, 2011 to show cause why this case should not be dismissed with prejudice [DE-120]. The Order to Show Cause further stated that if the parties did not comply the case would be dismissed with prejudice. No response has been filed. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED with prejudice.
