ORDER


As set forth by the Court at the Hearing held April 7, 2011, Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (doc. 25) should be and hereby is **GRANTED** for the reasons stated on the record at the Hearing. Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint (doc. 19) is hereby **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.

Should Plaintiffs seek to file an amended complaint which overcomes the deficiencies identified at the April 7 hearing, such amended complaint shall be filed by **May 23, 2011**. Further, any repleading shall be accompanied by a synopsis of no more than five (5) pages, explaining how the amendments remedy the deficiencies of the Amended Complaint filed August 9, 2010. Should

Plaintiffs replead, Defendants are hereby granted leave to file a response to Plaintiffs' synopsis. Any such response shall not exceed five (5) pages and must be filed within ten (10) calendar days of the repleading. No further briefing will be permitted.
